

### **New Testament reading – Ephesians 5.15-20**

#### **Live Wisely**

<sup>15</sup>Brothers and sisters, be careful then how you live, not as unwise people  
but as wise, <sup>16</sup>making the most of the time, because the days are evil.

<sup>17</sup>So do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. <sup>18</sup>Do  
not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but be filled with the  
Spirit, <sup>19</sup>as you sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among  
yourselves, singing and making melody to the Lord in your hearts,  
<sup>20</sup>giving thanks to God the Father at all times and for everything in the  
name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

### **Gospel reading – John 6.51-58**

#### **The Living Bread**

Jesus said to the crowd: <sup>51</sup>'I am the living bread that came down from  
heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I  
will give for the life of the world is my flesh.'

<sup>52</sup>The Jews then disputed among themselves, saying, 'How can this man  
give us his flesh to eat?' <sup>53</sup>So Jesus said to them, 'Very truly, I tell you,  
unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have  
no life in you. <sup>54</sup>Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal  
life, and I will raise them up on the last day; <sup>55</sup>for my flesh is true food

and my blood is true drink. <sup>56</sup>Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood  
abide in me, and I in them. <sup>57</sup>Just as the living Father sent me, and I live  
because of the Father, so whoever eats me will live because of me. <sup>58</sup>This  
is the bread that came down from heaven, not like that which your  
ancestors ate, and they died. But the one who eats this bread will live for  
ever.'
