

New Testament reading – Ephesians 2.19-22

One in Christ

¹⁹You are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the
saints and also members of the household of God, ²⁰built upon the
foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the
cornerstone. ²¹In him the whole structure is joined together and grows
into a holy temple in the Lord; ²²in whom you also are built together
spiritually into a dwelling-place for God.

Gospel reading – John 15.17-27

The World's Hatred

Jesus said to his disciples: ¹⁷I am giving you these commands so that you
may love one another. ¹⁸If the world hates you, be aware that it hated me
before it hated you. ¹⁹If you belonged to the world, the world would love
you as its own. Because you do not belong to the world, but I have
chosen you out of the world — therefore the world hates you.

²⁰Remember the word that I said to you, "Servants are not greater than
their master." If they persecuted me, they will persecute you; if they kept
my word, they will keep yours also. ²¹But they will do all these things to
you on account of my name, because they do not know him who sent me.

²²If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have sin; but
now they have no excuse for their sin. ²³Whoever hates me hates my

Father also. ²⁴If I had not done among them the works that no one else
did, they would not have sin. But now they have seen and hated both me
and my Father. ²⁵It was to fulfil the word that is written in their law,
"They hated me without a cause." ²⁶When the Advocate comes, whom I
will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the
Father, he will testify on my behalf. ²⁷You also are to testify because you
have been with me from the beginning.'

Post Communion prayer

Almighty God,
who on the day of Pentecost
sent your Holy Spirit to the apostles
with the wind from heaven and in tongues of flame,
filling them with joy and boldness to preach the gospel:
by the power of the same Spirit
strengthen us to witness to your truth
and to draw everyone to the fire of your love;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.
